

## STUDENT INCENTIVE PROGRAM (SIP): THE BASICS

- 1. Meet the eligibility requirements
  - a. Be a U.S. Citizen
  - b. Meet the physical standards specified by the U.S. Coast Guard (USCG)
  - c. Be enrolled in the U.S. Navy Reserve Strategic Sealift Midshipman Program (SSMP) and complete the requirements
  - d. Be enrolled at a state maritime academy and be in good standing
- Receive up to \$64,000 over four academic years from the Maritime Administration
- 3. Gain your USCG unlimited Merchant Mariner Credential
